Qatar - So shut up! Sorry we said shut up.

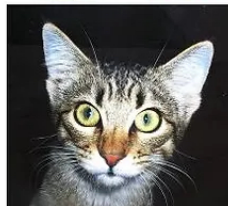
## Convoy lawyer desperately throws in Law & Order 'Dunt-Dunt!' for effect.
