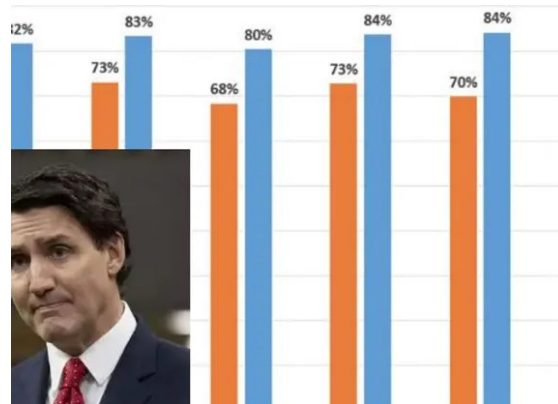
India orders Canadian diplomats to stop enjoying Naan bread.
